- Need to tighten up opening and closing shifts
 - Need a standards of operations list
 - Has been pretty laid back
- Projection template should be done at this point
 - JP to run through the projections and send to board
- \$1700 sponsorship
 - Reservations have been only 612 and non Surly
 - 2 weeks to our member and their VIP list Early access
 - JP will have the same number of hours for January just a shift in task, more training 145 hours - \$23/hr - \$3450
 - Max will be writing the checks after review of residency? Closeout proceedings?
 - JP will pay stokers as long as not exceeding \$700
 - Board approves the residency closeouts before approving the payment
 - Add the bottom line to template and what the CFO payment is modeled to be
 - Also add to the report if we don't hit the profit keep track of the hours banked and look at means to pay in the future.
 - 161 hours for December, 152 hours for November only 145 hours we approved per month
 - Only pay the 290 hours \$7900

Rodney is making a move – At the end of a residency the CFO payment comes from the residency's profit which includes net of stoker team payment minus fraction of annual overhead = payment to CFO. If CFO total hours aren't able to be compensated a bank of hours will be registered. Those will be paid if and when future residencies make above and beyond.

Max amending motion to include CFO is paid first from excess residency profits if back hours exist.
